### TASTING NOTES

February 2016 (Patrick Léon)

**Colour:** Bright luminous colour revealing a full wine

**Nose:** Generous and powerful aromas expressing a complex wine. The influence of excellent oak wood is present but will eventually recede with time.

**Palate:** Although still young, this is a very promising wine; well balanced, powerful. The tannins are smooth and well integrated already, releasing hints of vanilla and liquorice.

This wine will evolve well: Excellent bottle!

### STATS

**Blend:** 56 % Merlot – 21% Cabernet Sauvignon – 15% Cabernet Franc – 8% Petit Verdot

**Harvesting dates:** Merlot: october 5,14,15  
Cabernet Franc: october 16  
Cabernet Sauvignon: october 17  
Petit Verdot: october 17

**Ageing:** 15 months in barrels

**Alcohol content:** 13.5%

**Weather:** Wet, cold and humid spring. Dry and hot summer.  
Rainy autumn.
