TASTING NOTES

4 April 2021 (Bertrand Léon)

Nose Discreet fruity aromas combined with toasted notes.

Palate Very well balanced, good density, tannins are round and fine. The finale is still a little strung because of the young age of the wine, but in time, Felix has an appealing potential for ageing.
