Nose Very fruity and young.

Palate Tanins are well integrated and harmonious whilst remaining fresh. A long appealing finish. This wine has a particularity of blending the freshness of a young wine with maturity.

Blend 80% Merlot – 16% Cabernet Sauvignon
4% Cabernet Franc

Soil overview Merlot Silt and clay with a chalk sub soil and medium density gravel

Cabernet Sauvignon High density gravel with sub soil of silt and clay

Cabernet Franc Clay and chalk with on a clay-chalk sub soil

Vine density 9 100 vines / hectare (young vines)
5 200 vines / hectare (old vines)
