Nose Powerful presence of the fruits; very fine notes of

toast come through discreetly.

Palate Immediate presence of the fruits at first tasting; the presence of the tannins are felt but they are already well integrated. This wine is very crisp which, at this stage, predicts a lovely future ahead.
