TASTING NOTES

June 6 2022, Bertrand Léon

Nose Very precise and open. Rich in fruit. A hint of toasted aromas only appear discreetly a little later, perfectly integrated.

Mouth Very similar to the nose: appealing and fruity. At first, the wine is vivacious and well balanced; the young tannins, needing to relax, are mostly felt at the end. Felix de Biac 2019 has a lot of potential, but needs to breathe a little when drunk for the moment.
