## TASTING NOTES

**Color** bright spring yellow

**Nose** floral, generous, but also sea breeze

**Palate** Generous, round, generous in aromas, hints of pomelos with a soft sweeter finish

Elegant, delicate and well balanced wine. The oak is ever so slightly felt and well integrated. Pleasant maturity. Drink now.

<b>Pruning</b>	Semillon Côt Sauvignon Blanc Guyot Double Poussard

<b>Vinification &amp; Ageing</b>	Racking on the lees 7 months in new French oak barrels
